The Advantages of being the Editor means we didn't have to send out the November issue of the *Modern Square* till after the Fall Festival.

We made one BIG change to the *Modern Square*. You will no longer receive 12 issues of the E Edition. We (the Executive board) made the decision to only put out the E Edition when the printed edition is put out. These will come out 4 times a year: November, February, May and August. Reports will need to be sent in by the 5^{th} of the month prior to each of these months. If you wait until the last minute to renew your subscription, or sign up for The Modern Square (including at a Subscription Dance very close to the 10th of the month preceding the month of issue), you may MISS one or more issues, and may NOT be able to get a copy of the missed issues, even if you had material published in it.
