Most of the special dance photos are from club Facebook groups, although not everyone is on Facebook. If nothing's sent in or posted, nothing's published in The Modern Square, or on the ASSDF website. There's no word limit on club reports, but minor editing is done for typos, grammar, and continuity. The issue publication deadline is 3pm, US Central Time, on the Sunday, after the last Saturday of the month, before the month of issue.

If emails to you are returned, due to your box being full/over quota, or the address isn't valid, you won't receive notices on Modern Square releases or ASSDF club updates, until you contact me with updated info. Please let me know if you no longer want these emails.

Please CALL BEFORE TRAVELING, in case of last minute changes or cancellations. If you've been ill, feel ill on a dance night, or if weather is an issue, please stay home.

NONE of the ASSDF Officers will EVER send emails, Facebook messages, etc., asking for money, gift cards, etc.; those are SCAMS! Clubs with Facebook pages MUST police them, as scammers are posting things like "club T-Shirts", "death of a celebrity", "deleting all inactive members", "wanting part time work," (NOTHING to do with square dancing). These posts/emails have viruses to steal your identity, delete, destroy, or encrypt your data, where you'd have to pay a HUGE cost to get it back.

If you see these emails, DELETE them. And, if you see these ads, DON'T click on ANY part of them. Instead, report them to the group administrators, so the post can be deleted, and the poster can be banned from the group. Then, BLOCK that person in your email spam filter, and your Facebook profile. This helps keep that spam off your page. If not, someone will get their identity/data stolen, your Facebook page could get hacked, or you could be "left on the hook, financially".

The United Square Dancers of America – the national dancers' organization – awards merit-based scholarships to students who have shown their dedication to the promotion and perpetuation of the total square dance movement, including square dance, round dance, contra and clogging, and are members of an affiliated club.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

The United Square Dancers of America Founders Memorial Youth Fund expects to award one or more Foundation Scholarships on the basis of merit to high school seniors or college freshmen who are active square, round, contra or clog dancers, and

- Have a record of volunteer service in square dancing, and/or school, sporting or other social organizations such as church,
 4-H, FFA, scouting or similar groups.
- · Have outstanding leadership potential and communication skills.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

Each nominee must

- · Be an active square, round, contra or clogging dancer who is a member of an affiliated club;
- . Be a high school senior or college freshman planning to continue their education;
- . Submit a Nomination Form signed by the President of the applicant's USDA affiliate organization, and;
- · Be committed to the promotion and perpetuation of the total square dance movement.

NOMINATION PROCEDURES

The following items are required for each nominee:

- · Completed application.
- · Signed nomination form from USDA Affiliate Organization President (download form from USDA website)
- Three letters of recommendation One from your local square dance club of which you are a member, plus two more
 which can come from representatives of square dance clubs, schools, church, social clubs or long time acquaintances.
- Applicant's essay of approximately 500 words on the subject "The impact square dancing has had on my life."
- If additional space is required additional pages can be attached.

NOMINATION DEADLINE The complete nomination package must be received by February 1.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

A committee will review all nominations and selects the recipient(s) on the basis of

- · Extent and quality of service to square, round, contra or clog dancing
- · Leadership record for all activities.
- Demonstrated dedication to the promotion and perpetuation of the total square dance movement.
- · Future leadership potential, communication skills, and the likelihood of "making a difference" in square dancing

SELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT

The recipient will be announced in June each year at the Annual USDA Board of Directors meeting held in conjunction with the National Square Dance Convention®

IMPORTANT! In order for a Club to participate in the USDA Dancers Insurance Program, the Club must be a member of the ASSDF. This insurance program provides Accident Medical Insurance, which helps supplement a dancer's existing medical insurance; and Liability insurance, which protects the club and its members from financial loss due to unforeseen accidents, which may develop into litigation against members and organizations.

In the insurance information packet, there will be a blank club roster form to designate the paying insurance members. Please note any change in the venue you dance at, or if there has been a change in the insurance contact personnel when you return the roster.

Please remember if there are dancers within your club who are members of multiple clubs, the insurance fee will only be paid once. If you do not receive the insurance mailout by December 1, please contact ASSDF Treasurer and Insurance Coordinator, Sheila Gesing at 512-968-4876.





In feedback from dancers who attended the 73rd National Square Dance Convention® in Milwaukee, requests were made for the first name to be printed more prominently on conven-

tion badges. In order to accommodate the larger first name, Rhonda Bailey, the 74th NSDC Registration Chairman, noted other information may have to be omitted. The Registration Committee may not be able to place a dancer's hometown on the badge as a result of the bigger type size, but we should be able to print the dancer's

home state of residence.

In addition, Bailey emphasized if a dancer wants the number of conventions he or she has attended to be printed on the name badge, please notify registration with the information as soon as possible. She said not everyone included the number of conventions attended on the Registration Long Form, and if the information was not included or registration notified, it will not appear on the badge. ONLY name misspelling will be corrected at the convention, other information will not be cause for re-print.
