Nice men marry dancers. Real men become dancers.





**Prompt Renewal ...** If you wait until the last minute to renew your subscription, or sign up for The Modern Square (including at a Subscription Dance very close to the 10th of the month preceding the month of issue), you may MISS one or more issues, and may NOT be able to get a copy of the missed issues, even if you had material published in it.

**Remember** ... If you do not contact the Circulation Manager when you have a delivery issue, then there is no way for him to rectify it. The problem may be in the database record or with the Postal Service. Both can be fixed.

**Note** ... The ONLY time that a dancer should contact the Circulation Manager regarding someone else's subscription, is in the event of that person's death, so that the subscription can be cancelled.
