For much of the United States, except for Arizona, Hawaii, and the US Territories, **Daylight Savings Time** returns at 2am local time Sunday, March 9, 2025. Set your clocks, watches, timepieces, etc., that don't "**spring forward**" automatically, forward one hour, before you go to bed on Saturday night, March 8, 2025. Otherwise, you'll be **AN HOUR LATE** to church, work, square dance events, medical appointments, etc. Most computers, smartphones, etc., make the change automatically, but things like microwave ovens, DVD/VCR units, stovetop clocks, etc., may need a "manual spring forward".

A bill is in the Arkansas Legislature, which if passed, would mean that Arkansas would be on Central Standard Time year round. At this writing (Feb. 22, 2025), a final result on **HB 1069**, is **not** known.



Please let the Editor know if your email changes; or you won't get club updates (special dances, cancellations, changes), Modern Square releases, etc., if the email is returned as "**undeliverable**" (over quota mailbox, bad email address, etc.).

Due to vision issues, I no longer drive, and can't be at dances, etc. unless someone offers transportation. Please advise me if your info (club contact, dance day/time) in The Modern Square or on the ASSDF website, is wrong; as I can't fix it if I'm not told.

Most of the special dance photos are from club Facebook groups, although not everyone is on Facebook. If nothing's sent in or posted, nothing's published in The Modern Square, or on the ASSDF website. There's no word limit on club reports, but minor editing is done for typos, grammar, and continuity. The issue publication deadline is 3pm, US Central Time, on the Sunday, after the last Saturday of the month, before the month of issue.

If emails to you are returned, due to your box being full/over quota, or the address isn't valid, you won't receive notices on Modern Square releases or ASSDF club updates, until you contact me with updated info. Please let me know if you no longer want these emails.

Please CALL BEFORE TRAVELING, in case of last minute changes or cancellations. If you've been ill, feel ill on a dance night, or if weather is an issue, please stay home.

NONE of the ASSDF Officers will EVER send emails, Facebook messages, etc., asking for money, gift cards, etc.; those are SCAMS! Clubs with Facebook pages MUST police them, as scammers are posting things like "club T-Shirts", "death of a celebrity", "deleting all inactive members", "wanting part time work," (NOTHING to do with square dancing). These posts/emails have viruses to steal your identity, delete, destroy, or encrypt your data, where you'd have to pay a HUGE cost to get it back.

If you see these emails, DELETE them. And, if you see these ads, DON'T click on ANY part of them. Instead, report them to the group administrators, so the post can be deleted, and the poster can be banned from the group. Then, BLOCK that person in your email spam filter, and your Facebook profile. This helps keep that spam off your page. If not, someone will get their identity/data stolen, your Facebook page could get hacked, or you could be "left on the hook, financially".

Line Dance Floor Etiquette

Our dance floor is a place where people come together to exercise/socialise, enjoy friendships and have fun.

Enjoyment comes with respect and looking out for each other. These Golden Rules keeps our floors safe and fun for everyone to dance.

OUR FLOOR

- Never carry food, drinks, glass or cans across our dance floors. Spills can cause the floor to be sticky or slippery leading to falls. Also, it can be detrimental to the floor.
- If a dance is in progress, please do not walk through the lines. Move around the outside of the dance floor.
- If a dance is in progress that you wish to join, go to the end of the lines. Alternatively, if the dance is in progress and you need to leave, find the easiest quickest route out and be very careful of those dancing. Walking through the lines can be dangerous and cause falls. AND under no circumstances running.
- If the dance has started, please do not stay on the floor to talk or take photos. Move to the side, away from the dance floor.
- If you wish to watch a dance, please ensure you are away from the sides and do not obstruct the view of those dancers who are seated.

DANCING

- We were all Beginners once. When dancing near them, be mindful courteous and encouraging.
- Dance within your own space. The fuller the floor, the smaller the steps. Look out and be courteous to the dancers around you. Never let your feet, knees, arms or elbows become weapons on the dance floor. If you accidentally bump into anyone...always apologies, smile make sure they are ok and then continue in the right direction.
- Always remember to follow the dance program put together by the instructor running the Socials. If you wish to do another dance on the floor other than the one on the program as a split, it is always common courtesy to ask the Instructor to ensure that there will be enough floor space.

Last but not least...always respect your fellow dancers, have fun and enjoy each other's company and this makes for a wonderful day dancing:)



Stay powered up at the 74th NSDC

Make sure you stay connected while at the 74th National Square Dance Convention[®]. Battery running low on your cell phone or other devices? The Shreveport Convention Center has self-service charging kiosks powered by chargeFUZE located throughout the facility for your convenience.

Each station has approximately 45 portable chargers available with micro-USB, USB-C, and Lightning cables compatible with all iPhones, Androids, tablets, select laptops and headphones. A rental fee does apply. Most devices should fully charge in an hour or less. The kiosks can be easily seen in the convention center's hallways, but one can download the chargeFUZE App to quickly locate a charging station within the convention center.

How does it work?

 Use your device to scan the chargeFUZE kiosk's QR Code, follow the easy instructions to eject a portable charger.
 Charge your device on the go. The rental rate is \$2 per 30


2. Charge your device on the go. The rental rate is \$2 per 30 minutes up to \$40 max.





In feedback from dancers who attended the 73rd National Square Dance Convention® in Milwaukee, requests were made for the first name to be printed more prominently on conven-

tion badges. In order to accommodate the larger first name, Rhonda Bailey, the 74th NSDC Registration Chairman, noted other information may have to be omitted. The Registration Committee may not be able to place a dancer's hometown on the badge as a result of the bigger type size, but we should be able to print the dancer's home state of residence.

In addition, Bailey emphasized if a dancer wants the number of conventions he or she has attended to be printed on the name badge, please notify registration with the information as soon as possible. She said not everyone included the number of conventions attended on the Registration Long Form, and if the information was not included or registration notified, it will not appear on the badge. ONLY name misspelling will be corrected at the convention, other information will not be cause for re-print.
