Overall, the gators weren't happy with the cold temperatures.










I don't think Miss Tonia needs a bikini at snowy Virginia Beach today!!

For much of the United States, except for Arizona, Hawaii, and the US Territories, **Daylight Savings Time** returns at 2am Sunday, March 9, 2025. Set your clocks, watches, timepieces, etc., that don't "**spring forward**" automatically, forward one hour, before you go to bed on Saturday night, March 8, 2025. Otherwise, you'll be **AN HOUR LATE** to church, work, square dance events, medical appointments, etc. Most computers, smartphones, etc., will make the change automatically, but things like microwave ovens, DVD/VCR units, stovetop clocks, etc., may need a "manual spring forward".

A bill is in the Arkansas Legislature, which if passed, would mean that Arkansas would be on Central Standard Time year round. At this writing (Feb. 22, 2025), a final result on **HB 1069**, is **not** known.

Next, a "**Time Machine**" of sorts, or more like "**a stroll down memory lane**"; of what square dancing was like in the Little Rock Metropolitan Area in the late 80's/early 90's, -- this is as I (your Editor) remember them (I started lessons in August 1985, graduating just before Christmas that year. There were many other clubs (as noted in the "**In Memoriam**" file), but these are the clubs that I remember dancing with.

Most of these clubs and callers are long gone, but they're not forgotten. Some clubs danced every other week, while others danced weekly, but these are the days that they were dancing. If you have others, please let me know.




